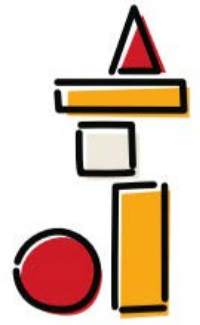

Materials for 0-24 Months

SENSORY PLAY
